Dear Parents and Carers,

**Autumn Term lunchtime and after school clubs.**

We are now in a position to share with you our clubs and enrichment activities offering for the Autumn term. As a reminder, there are four categories of club:

- Stay and Play and Wake Up Wellstead – wraparound care,
- Staff led clubs,
- Sporting clubs with Coach Ruben,
- Externally run clubs.

Stay and Play and Wake Up Wellstead continue to run as usual and provide wraparound care for parents that need to use before and after school clubs for childcare. You can book this via Scopay, using code 'A' for the first child you book a place for on any one day and code 'S' for any subsequent siblings you book in on that day. We recently added an additional option to Wake up Wellstead - you can book your child in for 8-8.30am, without any food, for £1 per child to cover staffing costs. This can be booked via Scopay, please select the code 'D'.

If your child has not previously attended the wraparound care provision, do please let the office know, so that we can add your child onto the cohort so that you can book online. If your child has additional needs, attends Ready2Learn, has a medical condition and/or an EHCP or has adult support during the school day, please let us know at least a week in advance so that we can ensure that we have sufficient staff in place to support them.

If your child attends Stay and Play and they would like to sign up for a sporting club during that time, they can do so at no extra cost.

**After school sports clubs – with Coach Ruben:**

To book after school clubs with Ruben, please log on to Scopay where his bookings will be collected. There is a small charge for these of £2.50 per session (unless you are booked into Stay and Play).

**For afterschool sports clubs:**

- Log on to Scopay and book Afterschool Sports Club using code A. If you would like your child to attend Afterschool Sports Club and then go to Stay & Play afterwards, please book onto Sports Club using code 'B' and then book on to Stay & Play in the usual way, using code 'A' or 'S'.
- The children will get changed in their classrooms and then meet in the library where Ruben will collect them. Please collect your children from the main office, unless they have permission to walk home. If they are attending Stay and Play after their club, Ruben will drop them off there.

You can request up to 3 clubs, please choose your order of preference as children will only be allocated 1 club to allow spaces for others. Please note that we cannot guarantee that your child will definitely have a club space. Confirmation of allocated spaces will be sent out as soon as possible but by Friday 12th September at the latest. Please remember that if your child chooses a club they must attend for the full number of weeks.

For after school clubs, it is our policy to call home to check if a child does not turn up for a club so that we know that they are safe. This can be a lot of extra work for the office staff and so if there are weeks that your child cannot attend, please inform the club leader by sending an email to the office. If we find that children are persistently not showing up for a club without notice, we will contact you and this may mean that their space is reallocated to someone else.

Please note that Dance Live will continue on from last term with the children that are already signed up.
